STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Compensation for Substitute Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 1901, 3rd \P is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Substitute teachers shall be compensated at a daily rate not less than 75% of the unit's average teacher daily salary for each day of service.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the amount of compensation for substitute teachers to a level more appropriate and in keeping with the times for professional services.
