### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning the Publication of Statements of Intent Concerning Referendum Issues.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 1 MRSA § 353, as last amended by PL 1979, c. 663, § 1, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

The Secretary of State shall include the explanatory statement on the ballot containing the measure explained.

- Sec. 2. 21 MRSA § 702-A is enacted to read:
- § 702-A. Ballots for constitutional amendments and referenda

Ballots for constitutional amendments and referenda shall contain the explanatory statement prepared by the Attorney General under Title 1, section 353.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that the Attorney General's explanatory statement prepared for constitutional amendments or referenda be included as part of the ballot itself.
