STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Clarify the Application of Military Service Credits to Retirement Benefits for Employees of Local Districts under the Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 1092, sub-§ 3, as last amended by PL 1979, c. 77, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

No military service credits provided for under section 1094, subsection 13, may be allowed in the computation of 20 to 25 years of service under this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the inapplicability of military service credits under Title 5, section 1094, subsection 13, to persons receiving the special retirement benefits provided in Title 5, section 1092, subsection 3.
