COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 278, L.D. 787, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Commencement of Terms for Members of
School Committees and Boards of School Directors."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in the last line (same in
L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "district"
the following: ', but not later than July 1st of the next
fiscal year'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in the 10th line
(8th line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word
"district" the following: ', but not later than July 1st of
the next fiscal year'

Further amend the Bill in section 3 in the last line
(same in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word
"election" the following: ', but not later than July 1st of
the next fiscal year'

Statement of Fact

The amendment specifies that the school board members
shall take office no later than July 1st.
