Further amend the Bill in section 3 in the last line (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure and symbol "5%" and inserting in its place the following: '10%'

Statement of Fact

The Blaine House Conference on Small Business made no recommendation as to the amount of the maximum adjustment. This amendment changes the amount of the adjustment from the 5% figure suggested in the original bill to 10%.
