IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Designating the Picnic Area on State Route 23 in Dexter as the Harold Keyte Memorial Picnic Area.

Preamble. Whereas, Harold Keyte served in the Legislature from 1965 to 1974; and

Whereas, Harold Keyte served as a member of the Transportation Committee during the same years; now, therefore, be it

Designation of the Harold Keyte Memorial Picnic Area. Resolved: That the picnic area on State Route 23 in Dexter be designated as the "Harold Keyte Memorial Picnic Area:" and be it further

Resolved: That appropriate plaques designating this area may be erected and maintained at no expense to the State and subject to approval of the Department of Transportation.
