### STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide 75% Reimbursement to a Municipality for General Assistance Costs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. 22 MRSA § 4450, sub-§ 3, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 417, § 2, is amended to read:
- 3. Net general assistance costs. "Net general assistance costs" means those direct costs incurred by a municipality in providing assistance to eligible persons according to standards established by the municipal officers and does not include the administrative expenses of the general assistance program includes administrative expenses determined to be eligible direct costs pursuant to rules and regulations of the Department of Human Services.
- Sec. 2. 22 MRSA § 4499, first sentence, as amended by PL 1979, c. 382, § 1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

The Department of Human Services shall reimburse the municipality for 75% of the municipality's net general assistance costs as defined in section 4450, subsection 3, when the department finds that the municipality has been in compliance with all requirements of this chapter.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for state reimbursement of 75% of a municipality's total local welfare costs, including administrative expenses.
