STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Prohibit Petition Drives at the Polls on Election Day.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

21 MRSA § 893 is enacted to read:

§ 893. Gathering signatures on election day

No person may solicit or take signatures for any initiative petition or referendum petition at the polls on election day.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the solicitation of initiative or referenda petition signatures at the polls on election day.
