STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize the Town of West Bath to Regulate Ice Racing on New Meadows Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

New Meadows Lake; ice racing regulation by West Bath. Notwithstanding any provisions of the Revised Statutes, the Town of West Bath is authorized to enact a municipal ordinance regulating ice racing on that portion of New Meadows Lake which is within the territorial limits of the Town of West Bath.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Town of West Bath to enact an ordinance regulating ice racing on New Meadows Lake, which is presently a lake under exclusive state jurisdiction.
