STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize the State Liquor Commission to Establish an Agency Discount Liquor Store at Jackman.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA § 451, first ¶, as amended by PL 1979, c. 161, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the commission, with the approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, may reduce the price of liquor in one agency store, located in Jackman.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill authorizes an agency discount liquor store in the town of Jackman.
