STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Require that Certain Town Reports List all Property Owners and Their Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 30 MRSA § 2225, sub-§ 3-A is enacted to read:
- 3-A. Certain municipalities to list property owners and taxes. In any municipality with a population under 1500, the report shall contain, at least once every 5 years, a list of all property owners in the town and the amount of tax assessed on each owner.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require towns of under 1500 people to include in their town report at least once each 5 years, a complete list of property owners and their taxes.
