COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A"to S.P. 351, L.D. 994, Bill, "AN ACT to Require that Legislators Include in their Ethic Reports Whether they are Union Members and Pay Union Dues During the Year."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the last paragraph before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Each member of the Senate and House of Representatives shall also file a statement listing the organizations of which he was a member during the preceding calendar year, to which he paid dues, and which are professional, trade, labor, fraternal or civic organizations. This statement shall be filed with the commission prior to the close of the 2nd week in February of each year.'
