Amend the Bill in that part designated "§1016-A." in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "Representatives" the following: ', whose primary source of income is negotiated for by a union,'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§1016-A." in the 4th line (3rd line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "unions" the following: ', by which he is represented,'

This amendment limits the reporting requirement to

Legislators whose primary source of income is negotiated for

by a union by which he is represented.
