COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 352, L.D. 995, Bill, "AN ACT to Promote Tourism by Providing Directional Signs for Publicity Bureau Offices."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Department of Transportation; cooperation. Signs erected pursuant to section 1 shall conform to state law.

The Maine Publicity Bureau shall obtain the approval of the Department of Transportation of the logo and the design, size and location of the directional signs. No expenditures may be made from Department of Transportation funds to or maintain establish the system of signs or erect/those signs.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment:

- 1. Requires the signs erected to conform to state law;
- 2. Requires the Maine Publicity Bureau to obtain the approval of the Department of Transportation for the design, size and location of the logo and signs; and
- Prohibits the use of department funds to establish and erect the signs.
