STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Promote Tourism by Providing Directional Signs for Publicity Bureau Offices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Maine Publicity Bureau; logo and directional signs. The Maine Publicity Bureau shall establish a suitable uniform logo, and system of directional signs using the logo, to indicate to the traveling public the route and distance to the various official information centers and cooperating offices of the bureau.
- Sec. 2. Department of Transportation cooperation. The Department of Transportation shall cooperate with the Maine Publicity Bureau in establishing the system of directional signs, under section 1, and in erecting those signs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for a system of directional signs to indicate to the traveling public the location of the various offices of the Maine Publicity Bureau.
