SENATE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 832, L.D. 999, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Truck Volume Labeling for Certain Wood By-Products."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'A carrier transporting loose sawdust or wood shavings for final delivery to a destination where they will be used in the production of agricultural commodities shall conspicuously label the volume capacity of the vehicle in cubic feet or cords. For the purposes of this section a cord means 128 cubic feet.

Any sale from a vehicle covered by this section shall be accompanied by a sales slip indicating the volume sold.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires the carrier to be labeled in cubic feet or cords, rather than cubic yards.
