IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Establish Truck Volume Labeling for Certain Wood By-Products.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

10 MRSA § 2623-A is enacted to read:

A carrier transporting wood by-products used in the production of agricultural commodities shall conspicuously label the volume capacity of the vehicle.

Any sale from a vehicle covered by this section shall be accompanied by a sales slip indicating the volume amount of by-product sold.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that a carrier transporting wood by-products used in agricultural commodities label the volume capacity of the vehicle and that sales slips of the products list the volume amount sold.
