STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Permit Persons 15 Years of Age and Older to Work until 10 P.M.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

26 MRSA § 774, 3rd ¶ is amended to read:

No minors under 16 15 years of age shall be employed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. and no minor 15 years of age or older may be employed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit minors 15 years of age or older to work until 10 p.m.
