AN ACT to Eliminate the Sales Tax on Clothing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 36 MRSA § 1760, sub-§ 42 is enacted to read:
- 42. Clothing. Sales of articles of clothing.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to exempt the sale of articles of clothing from the Sales and Use Tax.
