COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 378, L.D. 1136, Bill, "AN ACT to Exempt Certain Signs from the Billboard Law."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in paragraph J in the last at the end line (same in L.D.) by inserting/after the punctuation the following: 'and'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 23 MRSA §1913, sub-§1, ¶K is enacted to read:

K. Signs providing directions only to a seasonal place
of business engaged exclusively in selling agricultural
products raised or harvested on the premises. A business
may erect no more than 6 signs with a surface area not to
exceed 12 inches by 48 inches per sign.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt from the bill-board law directional signs for seasonal roadside produce stands which only sell crops grown on the same premises. The signs exempted may only show a change of direction from one way to another and are / to 6 with a surface area not exceeding 12 x 48 inches each.
