### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Compensation Paid to Judges and Justices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 4 MRSA § 4, first sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 663, § 5, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Each Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court shall receive an annual salary of \$36,637 until June 30, 1981, and an annual salary of \$39,568 until June 30, 1982, and an annual salary of \$42,733 thereafter; and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court shall receive an annual salary of \$38,354 until June 30, 1981, and an annual salary of \$41,422 until June 30, 1982, and an annual salary of \$44,736 thereafter.

Sec. 2. 4 MRSA § 102, first sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 663, § 6, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Each Justice of the Superior Court shall receive an annual salary of \$36,064 until June 30, 1981, and an annual salary of \$38,949 until June 30, 1982, and an annual salary of \$42,065 thereafter.

Sec. 3. 4 MRSA § 157, 4th sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 544, § 7, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Each judge shall receive an annual salary of \$33,202 until June 30, 1981, and an annual salary of \$35,858 until June 30, 1982, and an annual salary of \$38,727

thereafter; and the Chief Judge shall receive an annual salary of \$34,347 until June 30, 1981, and an annual salary of \$37,095 until June 30, 1982, and an annual salary of \$40,063 thereafter.

**Sec. 4. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Sec. 5. Retroactivity. Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of this Act are retroactive to July 1, 1981.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide an 8% salary increase for judges and justices for each of the 2 fiscal years, 1981-82 and 1982-83.
