STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Minimum Retirement Allowance under the State Retirement Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 5 MRSA § 1121, sub-§ 2, \P A, sub- \P (4), as amended by PL 1973, c. 788, § 19, is further amended to read:
 - (4) Any member who have 10 or more years of creditable service at retirement shall be entitled to a minimum of \$100 \$150 per month, further any former state employee or teacher who had 10 or more years of creditable service and who is receiving a retirement allowance including such adjustments as have been provided by section 1128, which is less than \$100 \$150 per month, shall be increased to \$100 \$150 per month the first day of the month following October 3, 1973.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the minimum retirement allowance from \$100 to \$150 under the Maine State Retirement law.
