IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Appropriate Funds to Upgrade Facilities of the Maine Center for the Blind.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation; Maine Center for the Blind. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
