COMMITTEE AMENDMENT A to H.P. 1002, L.D. 1199, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Tuition Reimbursement to Private Schools."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'This amount shall be defined as the insured value factor and it shall not exceed \$75 7.5% of a school's legal tuition rate per pupil in any one year.

Fiscal Note

The bill as amended will cost local units \$200,000 for the next 2 years. In the 3rd year, the costs will be part of the state and local allocation formula and the state's share will be \$100,000.

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the legal tuition rates of the bill from 15% to 7.5% and adds a fiscal note.
