STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning Tuition Reimbursement to Private Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 1292, first ¶, 4th sentence from end, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 746, § 14, is amended to read:

This amount shall be defined as the insured value factor and it shall not exceed \$75 15% of a school's legal tuition rate per pupil in any one year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the insured value factor used in the compilation of tuition fees under the education laws. The new ceiling would be 15% of a school's legal tuition rate. The 15%-rate would set a fair rental fee with a ceiling and be self-adjusting with the annual tuition rate.
