COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A" to S.P. 411, L.D. 1215, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Pharmaceutical Services Provided at Rural Health.

Centers."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§2922." subsection 2, first sentence, by striking out at the end, before the period, the following underlined words "a fee based on 75% of the fee assessed for a pharmacy" and inserting in their place the following underlined words 'the same fee required for a pharmacy under section 2901'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of that part designated "§2924." and inserting in its place the following: '§2924. Rules

The board shall adopt rules in conformity with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, to carry out the purposes of this subchapter.'

Statement of Fact

The amendment raises the fee for pharmacies in rural health centers to \$100, the regular fee for registration of a pharmacy, as intended by the board. It also adds language requiring adoption Maine of rules under the Administrative Procedure Act.
