IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning School Bus Inspections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 2017, 2nd sentence, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 685, § 2, is repealed as follows:

In addition, twice during the school year, between September 1st and November 30th and between March 1st and May 31st at a time and place convenient to the appropriate school authorities or an owner, each school bus, as defined in this Title, shall be submitted to an inspection conducted by the State Police

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to do away with the additional school bus inspections conducted by the State Police. School buses are already inspected twice each year and additional inspections are unnecessary.
