STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend the Charters of the Mars Hill Utility District and the Rumford Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1911, c. 290, § 9, 6th sentence, as repealed and replaced by P&SL 1971, c. 58, is amended to read:

Each member shall receive in full compensation for his services an allowance of \$300 \$400 per annum year.

Sec. 2. P&SL 1957, c. 143, § 8, 6th sentence, is amended to read:

The trustees shall meet monthly and specially as may be necessary and each shall receive compensation of \$10 \$30 for each regular or special meeting attended; provided, however, that the total annual compensation of each shall not exceed \$300 \$600.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the compensation of the trustees of the Rumford Water District and the Mars Hill Utility District.
