STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Reduce the Length of the Maine Legislative Session.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

3 MRSA § 2, 2nd paragraph, first sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 750, § 1, is amended to read:

The first regular session of the Legislature shall adjourn no later than $\frac{100}{80}$ legislative days after its convening and the 2nd regular session of the Legislature shall adjourn no later than $\frac{50}{80}$ 40 legislative days after its convening.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to reduce the length of the Legislative session from 100 days to 80 days in the first regular session and from 50 days to 40 days in the 2nd regular session.
