STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning the Payment of Taxes on Watercraft in the Municipality where the Boat is Located.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 603, sub-§ 2, ¶ I is enacted to read:

I. All watercraft and motors used to propel those watercraft.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that watercraft be taxed in the municipality where the watercraft is located, rather than in the municipality where the owner resides.
