STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning Sewer Lien Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

38 MRSA § 1208, 2nd ¶, last sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1977. c. 696, § 389, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

The costs to be paid by the rate payer shall be the sum of the fees for recording and discharge of the lien as established in Title 33, section 751, subsection 12, plus \$10 and all certified mail, return receipt requested, fees.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill equalizes the fees that may be charged when a sewer district lien is discharged with the fees charged when a property tax lien is discharged.
