COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $A$ " to H.P. 1181, L.D. 1405, Bill,
"AN ACT to Require Immediate Public Notification of Radioactive
Releases and Other Safety Related Events at Nuclear Power Plants."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "\$3332." by striking out subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:
'1. Notice. The president of any nuclear power generating facility in Maine, or his designee, shall provide notice of the events covered by this section to:
A. The public;
B. The Commissioner of Human Services; and
C. The Director of Civil Emergency Preparedness.' Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§3332.", subsection 2 by striking out paragraph $C$ and inserting in its place the following:
'C. Breakdowns or malfunctions of any safety related the
equipment that must be reported under/United States
Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10 , part 21 , as soon as possible, but no more than 24 hours after the discovery of the breakdown or malfunction.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment provides notice of events to the public, the Commissioner of Human Services and the Director of Civil Emergency Preparedness. It also cross-references the reporting requirements for breakdowns or malfunctions of safetyrelated equipment to current federal requirements.
