COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1181, L.D. 1405, Bill,
"AN ACT to Require Immediate Public Notification of Radioactive
Releases and Other Safety Related Events at Nuclear Power
Plants."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§3332." by striking out subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

- 'l. Notice. The president of any nuclear power generating facility in Maine, or his designee, shall provide notice of the events covered by this section to:
 - A. The public;
 - B. The Commissioner of Human Services; and
- C. The Director of Civil Emergency Preparedness.'

 Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§3332.",

 subsection 2 by striking out paragraph C and inserting in its place the following:
 - 'C. Breakdowns or malfunctions of any safety related the equipment that must be reported under/United States

 Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10, part 21, as soon as possible, but no more than 24 hours after the discovery of the breakdown or malfunction.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides notice of events to the public, the Commissioner of Human Services and the Director of Civil Emergency Preparedness. It also cross-references the reporting requirements for breakdowns or malfunctions of safety-related equipment to current federal requirements.
