STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Revenue Generated by Power Companies Exporting Electricity.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 1752, sub-§ 11, as last amended by PL 1979, c. 686, § 1, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

Electricity sold to a foreign electric company, as defined in Title 35, section 2308, or transmitted outside this State, shall be taxed under this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill taxes electricity exported outside the State.
