HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1375, L.D. 1556, Bill, "AN ACT to Promote Greater Efficiency through Alternative Working Hours in State Government."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the Bill in section 4 in that part designated "§903." subsection 1, by striking out all of the last sentence.

Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 2 to 5 to be sections 1 to 4.

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the sections mandating the proration of benefits as a result of job-sharing or part-time employment. Presently, proration of benefits are not mandated. Any change in such benefits should be negotiated under the collective bargaining law.
