COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1385, L.D. 1562,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Optional Local Funding of the State
Retirement System Membership by School Administrative Units
and to Allow Out-of-State Service Credits to Those Units."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and insert-
ing in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Allow Out-of-~~state~~
Credit for Teachers Entering the Retirement System on or After
January 1, 1976.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'5 MRS A §1094, sub-§ 12, ¶B, 2nd ¶, as enacted by PL 1975,
c. 622, §34, is repealed.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment replaces the original bill and allows any
teacher to add out-of-state service to his teaching time in
Maine for retirement purposes. The teacher must pay the
entire actuarial cost of their previous service. Current law
allows only those who taught prior to January 1, 1976, to buy
their out-of-state teaching time.
