## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the North Yarmouth Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P&SL 1957, c. 131, § 7 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- Sec. 7. Reports and meetings. A complete report of the doings of the district shall be rendered annually which report may be given as a part of the town report of the Town of North Yarmouth. All persons resident in the district and qualified to vote for Governor under the laws of this State shall be entitled to vote in any meeting of the district.
  - Sec. 2. P&SL 1957, c. 131, § 8, first sentence is amended to read:

After the meeting of the voters of the district for acceptance of this charter and after the organization of the board under section 6, the trustees shall have the same powers and perform the same duties as otherwise are exercised and performed by the selectmen of towns in correcting and preparing lists of the persons qualified to vote in said the district and for that purpose they shall be in session at the place designated for holding the meeting between the hours of 10

o'clock in the forenoon and 12 o'clock noon on the secular day next before the date of every meeting, and also 2 hours before the opening of the meeting, and notice thereof shall be given in the call of the meeting.

Sec. 3. P&SL 1957, c. 131, § 12, 2nd ¶, first sentence, as amended by P&SL 1975, c. 111, is further amended to read:

Said the bonds, notes and evidences of indebtedness may be issued to mature serially or made to run for such periods as the trustees may determine, but none of them shall run for a longer period than 40 years from the date of original issue thereof; provided, however, that no more than \$200,000 of said bonds, notes and other evidences of indebtedness shall be outstanding at any one time.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends the charter of the North Yarmouth Water District by amending the provisions concerning the annual report, the meetings of the district and the term for bond issues.
