SENATE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 1411, L.D. 1576, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Periodic Justification of Departments and Agencies of State Government under the Maine Sunset Law."

Amend the bill in Part A by striking out section 86 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 86. 23 MRSA §3414, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 380, Part B, §6, is repealed and the following enacted in its place: §3414. Amount paid by railroad corporation limited

No railroad corporation may be required to expend, under sections 3411 to 3413, more than \$110,000 during any period of 3 consecutive calendar years.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment replaces, in Title 23, section 3414, a provision limiting the amount which a railroad corporation may be required to expend on certain construction projects related to rail or highway crossings under Title 23, sections 3411 to 3413. Section 86 of LD 1576 repeals the entire section 3414.
