SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1423, L.D. 1577, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Laws of Maine."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.

Further amend the bill in section 6 in the 7th line (6th line in LD) by inserting after the underlined word "missions" the underlined words 'throughout New England and New York'

Further amend the bill in section 6 by inserting at the end of subsection 11 the following underlined sentence:
'Any purchases made as a result of that coordination shall be by competitive bid.'


Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes section 3 of the bill, clarifies that promotional missions permitted by section 6 of the bill can only be made in New England and New York, and requires purchasers made by the State Development Office for promotional purposes be made by competitive bid.
