COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{A} " to H.P. 1431, L.D. 1582, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Definition of State Employee under the State Employees Labor Relations Act."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

- 'Sec. 3. 26 MRSA §979-A, sub-§6, ¶¶I and J are enacted to read:
 - I. Who is appointed to a major policy-influencing position as designated by Title 5, section 711, subsection 2; or
 - J. Who substantially participates in the formulation and effectuation of policy in a department or agency or has a major role, other than a typically supervisory role, in the administration of a collective bargaining agreement in a department or agency.'

Statement of Fact

Representation in collective bargaining of certain state employees and officials is inconsistent with their duties. This amendment assures that the intent of the bill to exclude these employees from representation is carried out in a reasonable and fair manner.
