SENATE AMENDMENT B"to H.P. 1440, L.D. 1583, Bill, "AN ACT Making Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operation of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1982, and June 30, 1983."

Amend the bill in Part A, under the caption "DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL SERVICES" by striking out all of "Library Development Services" and inserting in its place the following:
