COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 602, L.D. 1600, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Petroleum Liquids Transfer Vapor Recovery Law."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and before the *E*mergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'A. This section shall be applicable in the Metropolitan Portland, Portland Peninsula and Central Maine Air Quality Control Regions of the State, except that, with respect to the Central Maine Air Quality Control Region, the Board of Environmental Protection may by regulation, with consent of the United States Environmental Protection Agency, exclude the region from the scope of this section, or modify the requirements of this section, as the public interest requires to afford equitable treatment to bulk gasoline terminals in the Central Maine and Downeast Air Quarity Control Regions.' ¥R

## Statement of Fact

This amendment leaves the change of any terms of transfer vapor recovery regulation in the Central Maine Air Quality Control Region to the determination of the Board of Environmental Protection with the consent of the United States Environmental Protection Agency so as to insure compliance with the State Implementation Plan under the Federal Clean Air Act.
