HOUSE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{A} " to H.P. 1476, L.D. 1608, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend, Revise and Codify the Landlord-Tenant Laws."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 5. 14 MRSA §6003 is amended by adding at the end
a new paragraph to read:

If either party in a forcible entry and detainer action requests a recorded hearing, the court shall schedule it as soon as practicable, but no later than 7 days after the return day. Any defendant requesting a recorded hearing shall be prepared to file a written answer enumerating defenses on or before the return day.'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 5 to 13 to be sections 6 to 14.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to restore language which was in the original legislation.
