SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1486,
L.D. 1613, Bill, "AN ACT to Promote the Maine Potato Industry
by Improving the Quality of Packing and Marketing Maine Potatoes."

Amend the Amendment by inserting before the last
paragraph before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 12
and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 12. Appropriation. The following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
of this Act.

The Commissioner of
Agriculture, Food and Rural
Resources shall provide no
more than \$30,000 each year
to the Maine Potato Quality
Control Board which shall use
these funds for purposes of
the Revised Statutes, Title 7,
chapter 103, subchapter X,
article 4. The remaining funds
shall be used to reduce the
cost of shipping point
inspections.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides the funds necessary to implement
a potato quality control program for Maine tablestock

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by funding the Maine Potato Quality Control Board and a portion of the shipping point inspection costs for participan in the Maine bag program.
