


SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1498, L.D. 1618, Resolve, for Laying of the County Taxes and Authorizing Expenditures of Penobscot County for the Year 1981.

Amend the Bill in section 2, in the last line, ^{by striking out} /the punctuation and words "; and be it further" and inserting in their place the following:

'The county shall not exceed the expenditures specified in this section unless first obtaining the  approval of the legislative delegation; and be it further'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add wording which will require the county to have the unanimous approval of the legislative delegation before exceeding ^{the} expenditures specified in section 2 of the bill.
