## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES (Filing No. H-473) 110TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "" to H.P. 1514, L.D. 1631, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Laws Governing School Administrative Districts and Community School Districts."

Amend the Bill in section 3, in that part designated "<u>§222-A.</u>" subsection 4, paragraph A, by striking out all of subparagraph (3) and inserting in its place the following:

> '(3) The agreement shall establish that the dissolution will not cause a need within 5 years from the effective date of dissolution for school construction projects which would be eligible for state funds. This limitation does not apply where a need for school construction existed prior to the effective date of the dissolution or where a need for school construction would have arisen even if the district had not dissolved.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment makes it clear that municipalities which had a need for a new school prior to the effective date of dissolution, or withdrawal under section 222-C, would be eligible for state aid for school construction projects.
