SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 629, L.D. 1638, Bill,
"AN ACT to Increase Local Control of Water Districts."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§3223." in subsection 4 by striking out all of the first 2
sentences and inserting in their place the following:

'The trustees shall receive compensation as recommended by
them and approved by a majority of the municipal officers of
the municipality, including compensation for any duties they
perform as officers, as well as for their duties as trustees.
For districts serving more than one municipality, any change
in the compensation received by the trustees for any duties
they perform within the district shall be recommended by
them and approved by majority vote of the municipal officers
in municipalities representing a majority of the population
within the district.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§3224." in the 6th and 7th lines (5th line in L.D.)
by striking out the underlined words "published by the
appropriate federal agency" and inserting in their place the
following: 'defined in Title 5, section 1001, subsection 6-A'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§3226." by striking out all of the 2nd underlined
sentence and inserting in its place the following: 'For any
water districts formed before that date, any provision in the
governing private and special law, that is, the charter, which
is not in compliance with this chapter may remain in force,

except that section 3223, subsections 4 and 5, shall apply to those districts on January 1, 1982, and any contrary portion of the water district charter shall be considered repealed on that date.'
