HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1540, L.D. 1655, Bill, "AN ACT Promoting Alcoholism Prevention, Education, Treatment and Research."

Amend the Bill in section 8 in that part designated "§474." by striking out all of subsection 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Amount of premium. The premium imposed by subsections 1 and 2 shall be 5¢ per gallon, or its metric equivalent, or fraction or multiple thereof, on all malt beverages sold in this State; 15¢ per gallon, or its metric equivalent, or fraction or multiple thereof, on all wine containing 14% or less alcohol by volume sold in this State; 12¢ per gallon, or its metric equivalent, or multiple or fraction thereof, on all sparkling wines manufactured in or imported into this State; \(\frac{62 \ 1/2¢}{2} \) per proof gallon as the term proof gallon is defined in the United States Code, Title 26, Section 5002, or its metric equivalent, or fraction or multiple thereof, on all spirituous liquors and wines containing more than 14% alcohol by volume sold in this State.

Statement of Fact

These figures are the equivalent in cents per gallon of the original 1¢ per fluid ounce premium in the bill.
