HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 650, L.D. 1676, Bill, "AN
ACT to Continue the Maine Turnpike Authority."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§314." in subsection 1, paragraph D in the 3rd line (2nd
line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined words "Kennebec
County" the following: ', except that there shall be no toll
facilities or barriers, and no tolls may be charged north of the
exit designated, on June 3, 1981, as EXIT 10, NORTH PORTLAND'

EXIT 10, North Portland.
