HOUSE AMENDMENT "~~D~~" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 649,
L.D. 1677, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Corrections of Errors and
Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before
the emergency clause the following:

Sec. 1. 13-B MRSA §709, sub-§4, first sentence, as amended
by PL 1981, c. 307, §3, is further amended to read:

At the time an executive committee or any other committee is
created, or at any time thereafter, the board of directors may
designate one or more alternate members of such committee, and
may specify their order of preference, provided that alternate
members of an executive committee may be designated only from
among members of the board of directors.'

Further amend Part B by renumbering the sections to read
consecutively.

Statement of Fact

This amendment corrects a contradiction overlooked in Public
Law 1981, chapter 30, which requires members of an executive committee
to be board members, but permitted alternate members to be nonboard
members.
